UMPIRE CODE OF CONDUCT

In addition to Mundaring Netball Club's General Code of Conduct, you must meet the following requirements regarding your conduct during any activity participated in or held by Mundaring Netball Club in your role as a member of Mundaring Netball Club and an umpire for EHNA.

- 1. Umpire in accordance with the Official Rules of the Game.
- 2. Treat all players, coaches, bench officials and other umpires with respect.
- 3. Place the safety and welfare of players above all else, including by:
 - 1. Ensuring the court and its surrounds are compliant with the rules; and
 - 2. Taking appropriate action to manage dangerous play.
- 4. Maintain a high standard of personal behaviour at all times.
- 5. Be a positive role model through behaviour and personal appearance projecting a favourable image of netball and umpiring at all times.
- 6. Be courteous, respectful and open to discussion and interaction with other netball participants. Be available to answer questions regarding rules and interpretations (at the appropriate times).
- 7. Maintain or improve your current performance level and seek continual improvement.

 Maintain a good understanding and knowledge of the rules of the game and any changes or amendments.
- 8. Give full attention and concentration throughout the entire game and be consistent in applying the rules.
- 9. Use a loud clear voice to state penalties.
- 10. Ensure players, coaches, parents and spectators abide by the rules of conduct.
