## GENERAL CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all people involved in netball regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- 2. Be ethical, fair, considerate and honest in all dealings with others.
- 3. Be responsible and accountable for your conduct.
- 4. Be a positive role model.
- 5. Show concern and caution towards others who may be sick or injured.
- 6. Operate within the rules and spirit of netball including national and state guidelines, constitution and policies which govern Netball Australia, Member Organisations and Affiliates and Mundaring Netball Club's Constitution, By-laws and Policies.
- 7. Do not use your involvement with netball to promote your own beliefs, behaviours or practices where these are inconsistent with those of Mundaring Netball Club.
- 8. Always place the safety and welfare of children above other considerations.
- 9. Refrain from conduct which could be regarded as sexual harassment, discrimination, bullying or victimisation.
- 10. Demonstrate a high degree of individual responsibility especially when dealing with persons under 18 years of age, as your words and actions are an example.
- 11. Avoid unaccompanied and unobserved actions with person sunder 18 years of age, wherever possible.
- 12. Refrain from any behaviour that may bring Mundaring Netball Club and the sport of netball into disrepute.
- 13. Support and promote the provision of a safe environment for the conduct of the activity (whether it is training, games or other club activities).
- 14. Comply with all relevant Australian laws (Federal and State), particularly anti-discrimination, occupational health and safety and child protection laws.
- 15. Abide by the relevant Mundaring Netball Club role-specific Codes of Conduct and understand the consequences if you breach, or are aware of any breaches, of this Code of Conduct.
