PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

In addition to Mundaring Netball Club's General Code of Conduct, you must meet the following requirements regarding your conduct during any activity held by or under the auspices of Mundaring Netball Club in your role as a player.

- 2. Participate fairly and safely.
- 3. Play by the rules.
- 4. Play for the fun of it, not to please parents or coach. The goal is to enjoy the sport and improve your skills.
- 5. Respect the decision of the umpires don't argue with them. Be courteous and use the correct process when seeking a rule clarification. Let your captain or coach ask questions at appropriate intervals.
- 6. Be responsible for your own actions and respectful of others control your temper, mind your language and be punctual for games and training.
- 7. Work equally hard for yourself and your team your team's performance will benefit and so will your own.
- 8. Be a good sport. Applaud all good play, by your own team and opponents.
- 9. Treat all players as you yourself would like to be treated. Respect the talent, potential and development of fellow players and competitors.
- 10. Don't interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of any player. Refrain from behaviour that could be regarded as sexual harassment, discrimination or victimisation.
- 11. Be frank and honest with your coach concerning illness and injury and your ability to train and play fully.
- 12. Respect and acknowledge the contribution of those who create the opportunity for you to play (eg. scorers, coaches, umpires, administrators, club officials).
