## SPECTATOR CODE OF CONDUCT

In addition to Mundaring Netball Club's General Code of Conduct, you must meet the following requirements regarding your conduct during any activity held by or under the auspices of Mundaring Netball Club in your role as a spectator.

- Remember that most players (particularly children) participate in netball activities for fun.
   They are not participating for the entertainment of spectators and they are not professional athletes.
- Applaud good performance and efforts by all players your team and the opposition. When
  watching a game congratulate both teams for their performance regardless of the game's
  outcome.
- Respect the decision of the umpires. Encourage players to play according to the rules and the official decisions and develop your own knowledge of the rules.
- Never ridicule, scold or abuse a player for making a mistake during a competition.
- Do not use foul language, sledge or harass administrators, coaches, players, umpires or other spectators. Be respectful of the rights of others.
- Condemn the use of violence in any form, be it by administrators, coaches, players, umpires or other spectators.
- Support the use of age appropriate development activities and modified rules.
- Encourage players always to play according to the rules.
